

- <u>English</u>: We are going to be following the 'Talk for Writing' structure within our English lessons.
- The children will learn a story or non-fiction text and will innovate it in order to create their own.
- Children will continue to have daily phonics lessons.
- We will be focusing on sentence structure and punctuation as well as handwriting and presentation.

<u>Maths:</u> We will be focusing on number work, counting, ordering, reading and writing numbers. We will also have a strong focus on addition and subtraction. Later on in the year, we will extend this to multiplication and division.

We will also have some focus on 2D and 3D shapes as well as different measurements.

Please continue working on number recognition at home with your child.

Reading

- All children are expected to read for at least 10 minutes every night.
- Please record your child's reading in their Reading Records. The books will be changed regularly, as long as we can see they have been read at home. (Read with ______.)
- As a school we have a reading reward race-track. If children have read at least 3 times a week and it has been recorded in their reading record they will move around the racetrack and receive prizes as they go.
- We ask that your child brings their reading book and record in to school every day so we can see how your child is progressing.
- Please feel free to read any books you have at home and also record these reads in their reading diaries - and remember to ask lots of questions!



Trips

During the Autumn term there will be a trip to Wat Tyler Park, Wednesday 8th October, to explore the historic cottages and go on a sensory walk. This will consolidate the learning for History and Science.

There will be an Enrichment day on 27th November which will focus on map making.
