What we are learning this term:

English: We are continuing to follow the Talk for Writing structure within our English lessons. The children will learn a story or non-fiction text and will use it to inspire their own creative writing.

Encourage your children to use story maps and 'box-up' their own stories at home.

Ask them about key characters and why they act as they do; why authors use certain words or phrases and why scenes are set in the locations they are.

They may enjoy keeping a diary to practise the writing skills taught in school.



What we are learning this term:

<u>Maths</u>

We will continue to learn the four different operations $(+, -, \times \text{ and } \div)$. Please encourage your children to use the different vocabulary for each operation.

Copies of the Calculation Policy can be found on our website, which shows you the methods we will be teaching the children this year.

Olympic Maths

Each week the children will have a timed (3 minute) test on their times tables in their maths group.

Please help your child learn their tables off by heart. They should know all of their tables to 12x12


They need to be able to answer in 5 seconds or less!

Reading


Reading books can be changed weekly. Changes are usually made if children have finished their books.




