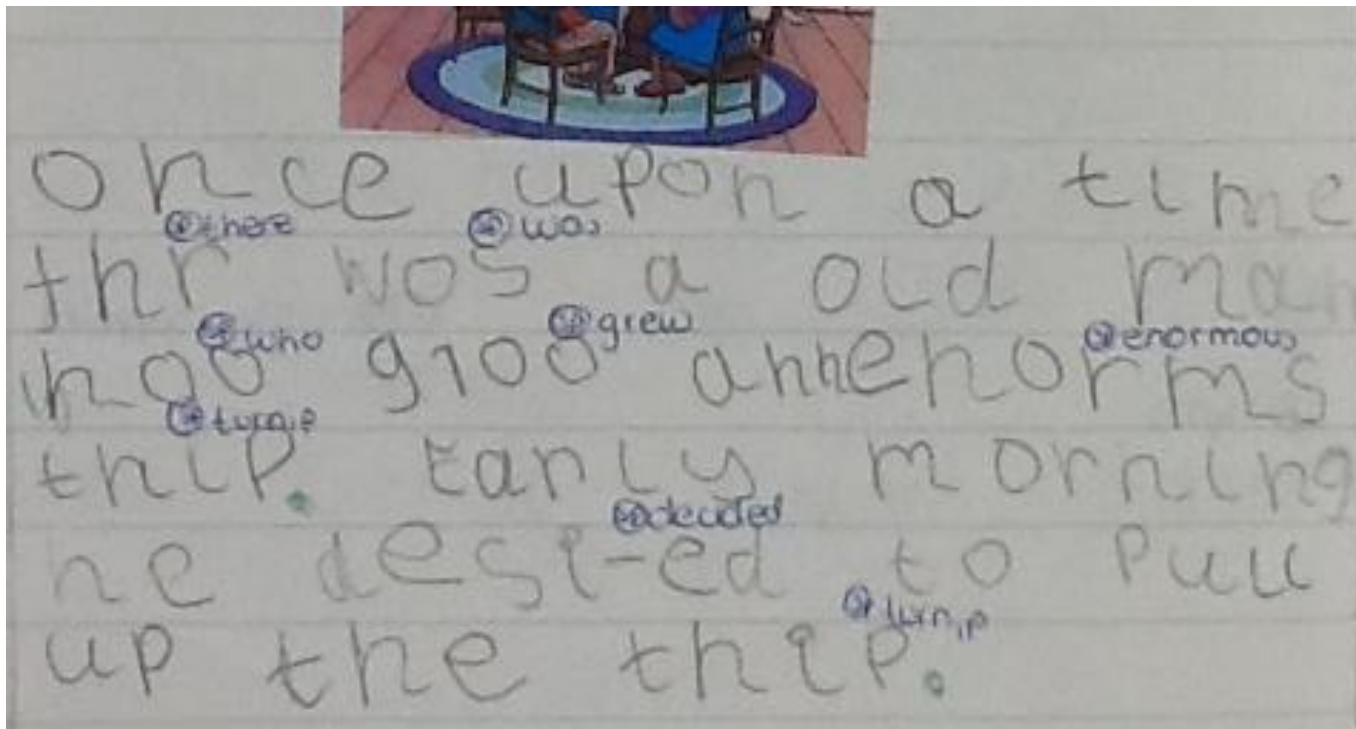

# Early Learning Goals

Physical Development	Literacy
<p><u>Fine Motor Skills:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Hold a pencil effectively in preparation for fluent writing - using the tripod grip in almost all cases.</li><li>• Use a range of small tools, including scissors, paintbrushes and cutlery.</li><li>• Begin to show accuracy and care when drawing.</li></ul>	<p><u>Writing:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Write recognisable letters, most of which are correctly formed.</li><li>• Spell words by identifying sounds in them and representing the sounds with a letter or letters.</li><li>• Write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others.</li></ul>

# Writing in EYFS

- ▶ Promote independent writing
- ▶ Children phonetically sounding words out that aren't always spelt correctly
- ▶ Writing some simple red words (he, the, me, she, we...)

- Usually 20 minutes long.



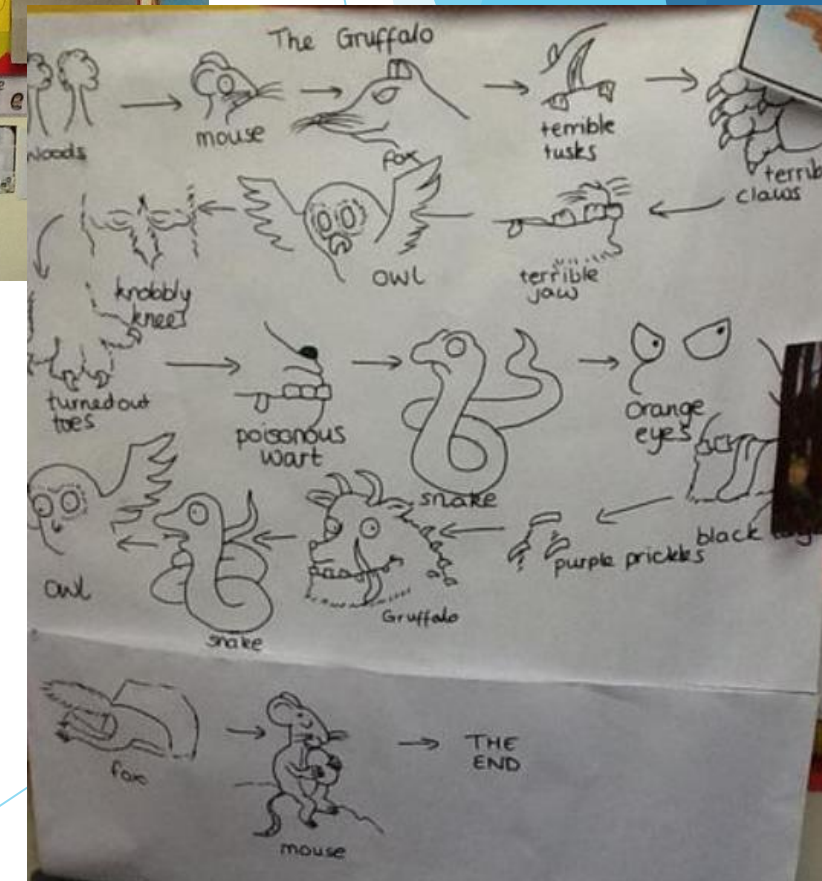
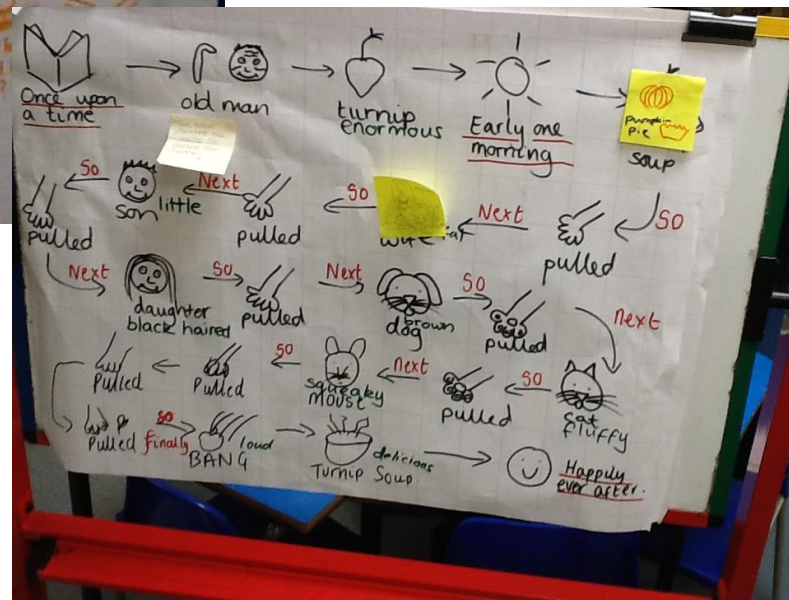

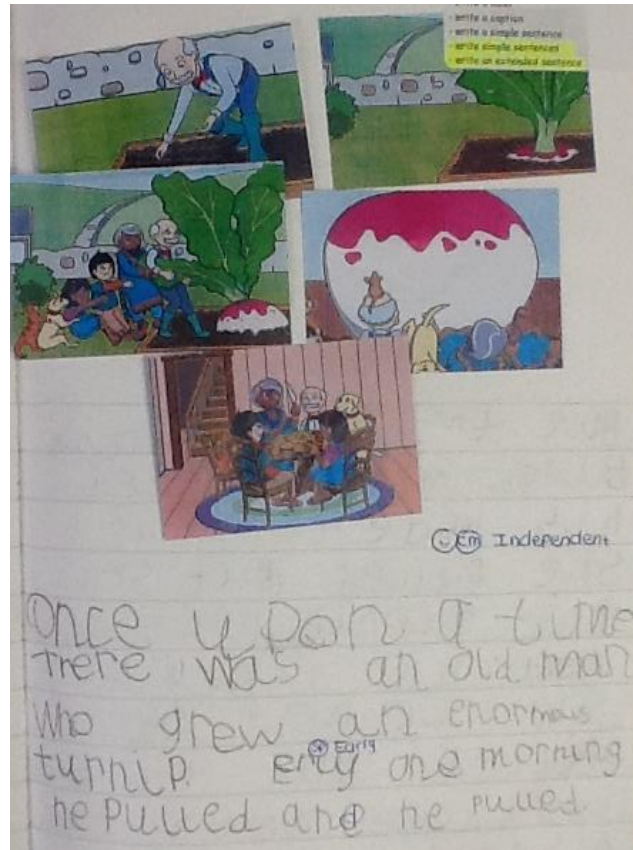
