## **Wraparound Care: September 2024**

Dear parents/carers,

As you will know through previous correspondence, in September we will be offering wraparound care for our school-aged pupils (Reception - Year 6).

The before school care will run from 7:30am - 8:40am and will include an offer of cereal, toast or a bagel. (Please be aware, food will not be offered after 8am.) The cost of a morning session will be £5 for your first child and £4 for additional siblings.

The afterschool care will run from 3:15pm - 6:00pm and will include an offer of a warm, light tea (for example, wraps, toast, bagels or small pizzas). The cost of an evening session will be £15 for your first child and £12 for additional siblings.

The care will be run by our school staff and after school sessions will include planned activities such as, movie nights, gardening, fitness games, playing outside and science experiments.

In order to secure your child's place for these sessions, you will need to email [admin.qha@catrust.org.uk](mailto:admin.qha@catrust.org.uk) to request a contract. Payments must be made weekly in advance of children attending the sessions. Children whose parents have not paid will be unable to attend the sessions. If children do not attend their prepaid sessions, costs will still be incurred due to prepaid staffing capacity.

The option to pay will go live on Arbor once contracts have been returned. You will be able to book sessions for the whole half term, but please note that spaces are limited.

We will continue to offer our before school and after school sports clubs as usual and these will be available to book when we return in September.
