<b>PE equipment</b>	Contamination of equipment once it has been used	Pupils and staff	Equipment will need to be cleaned after each use. Large black bin filled with Milton where equipment can be dunked after use in order to be washed Hand washing will routinely take place at the start and end of lessons There will be no sharing of sports bibs				
<b>First Aid</b>	Resulting in direct transmission of the virus	Pupils and staff	PPE equipment to be readily available in First Aid bag for staff to administer First Aid immediately if needed whilst on MUGA/outdoor playgrounds				
<b>Group sizes</b>	Contact between pupils during physical activities	Pupils and staff	Class/year group bubbles adhere to Government guidance and allocated Sports Coach teaches same classes. Within the class, pupils will be split into smaller groups to carry out their activities				
<b>Lack of social distancing in the corridors</b>	resulting in direct transmission of the virus	Pupils and staff	One child going to toilet at one time Messages to office for medical support etc can be made through use of walkie talkie Share instructions with children concerning going and returning to toilet				
<b>Wet weather</b>	Restricted to use of indoor equipment ie hall	Pupils and staff	Where possible PE should be done outdoors If the hall is available, one bubble of students may use this area Social distancing must be adhered to and no equipment can be used unless it has been cleaned Strict hand washing will be put in place before and after the lesson				
<b>MUGA Pitch</b>	Contact of pupils during physical activity	Pupils and staff	Gates to the pitch will be tied open so the handles are not touched by anyone Two bubbles can be on the pitch at the same time, divided by the net across the centre of the

<b>Lunchtime on the MUGA</b>	Contact of pupils during physical activity	Pupils and staff	<p>If used gates to the pitch will be tied open so the handles are not touched by anyone</p> <p>Two bubbles can be on the pitch at the same time, divided by the net across the centre of the pitch</p> <p>Children will work in their own zone that will be marked out on the floor</p> <p>Hand washing will routinely take place at the start and end of lessons</p>				
<b>After School Clubs</b>	Contact of pupils during physical activity	Pupils and staff	<p>When school clubs resume - gates to the pitch will be tied open so the handles are not touched by anyone</p> <p>Two bubbles can be on the pitch at the same time, divided by the net across the centre of the pitch</p> <p>Children who attend the after school club will have to be from the same bubble they have maintained throughout the day</p> <p>Children will work in their own zone that will be marked out on the floor</p> <p>Equipment used will be washed after use</p> <p>Hand washing will routinely take place at the start and end of lessons</p>
